

Thai Digits

... numbers. Most written material predating the 1929 coup uses them rather than the more familiar Arabic numerals. ...Unfortunately Thai numerals are not easily recognised by many adult Thais, though they are still taught in schools. You may note that the glyph for the digit 0 bears a strong resemblance to that of the Arabic. In common with many numeric systems used before the Arab based one became commonplace, Thai does not have it own representation for nought and borrows this from Arabic. The digit representing 9 in this strip is taken from the Angsana representation, which appears to be the most recognised form of the 3 representations that exist.
